# **Social Cognition**

- Understanding each others mind
- Sharing ideas, concepts
- Ability to watch things from others perspective
- Communicating ideas, facts
- Bridging mental maps
- Imagining yourself on others side
- Participating in culture development



# Social Issues – simple beings

- Sharing Tasks / Cooperating
  - Emergence
    - Collective / Swarm behavior
    - School of fishes / Flock of birds
      - Complex behavior can be observed
      - Instinctive individual basis



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## Social Issues – simple beings

- Communication through signals exchange
  - Pheromone (smell)
  - Noise (sound)
  - Movements (visual)
- Communicating through warnings
  - Signals with unique messages
  - Pure reactive behavior
  - Easy recognition
  - Instinctive
  - Messages
    - not compositional
  - Understanding
    - direct association signal meaning



# Social Issues – more complex beings

- Sharing Tasks / Cooperating
  - Joining individual and collective goals
    - Stablishing and following rules
    - Groups of wolves or lions
      - Strategy and planning
      - Hierarchy



# Social Issues – more complex beings

- Communication through signals exchange
  - Smell
  - Noise (sound)
  - Movements (visual)
- Communicating through warnings
  - Signals with compositional messages
  - More elaborated behavior
  - Sophisticated recognition
  - Not pure instinctive
  - Messages
    - compositional
  - Understanding
    - Complex association signal meaning
    - Involving knowledge

  - Body (face) expressions




### Social Issues – humans

#### Human Universals

- Language acquisition
- Detecting emotions
- Sense of self
- Perception of status
- Color terms
- Object recognition
- Landscape preferences
- Mental maps
- Food aversion, flavor preferences
- Deception, humor, gossip, nepotism, envy, ....
- Sexual attraction, romantic love, jealousy, pregnancy sickness
- ....
- Substrate (brain/body) providing guides for anything else



#### Insects

- Sharing of basic information
- Colony survival

#### Mammals

- Sharing of more elaborated concepts
- Hunting plans, feeding and mate strategies

#### Humans

- Sharing of ideas, knowledge, culture
- Humankind cultural evolution

Speech (Language)



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- Language as an instrument
  - Communicating
    - Ability to share ideas upon a common basis (constructed)
    - Many kinds of language
      - Verbal, gestural, pictorial, etc.
  - Self Reflection
    - Building / Structuring Concepts
  - Language Centers
    - Broca and Wernick areas
      - Some level of specialization (language)
      - But general (any language)
        - » This leads to the universal concept of language
          - Noam Chomsky universal grammar structures



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### Syntax

- Rules composition of words in sentences and sentences in speeches
- Possible combinations to carry comprehensible meaning


### Generative grammar

- Key features behind any natural languages
- Enabled by special neural circuits specially in humans
- Common basis for language development




- Neuroscience
  - Language Centers
  - Cortical areas
    - Broca & Wernick
- Cognitive Linguistics
  - Study of linguistics funded by scientific knowledge acquired about cortical areas and their associated mental functions
  - Expression (speech)
    - Broca area
  - Comprehension (Listening and Comprehension)
    - Wernick area





- Language and Communication
  - Dedicated centers for linguistic processing
    - Interlocution (Speaking/Listening)
      - Communication supported by Language
    - Thought (Self Reflection)
      - Reasoning supported by language
      - Loud and internal speak
         (closed circuit) speaking to
         yourself



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


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# Section 3

### General versus Special Purpose

- The cathedral concept
  - Many specific centers (chapels) around a central place (nave)
  - Coexisting: specific(chapels) and moregeneral / integrativefunctions (nave)





### **Emotion**

#### Modulator

- Cognitive processes modulated by emotional conditions
  - Emphasized / Stimulated or Attenuated
  - Acting as filters or enablers from those process that are more important on some circumstances
  - Attention
  - Self preservation
  - Danger avoidance



### **Emotion**

- Body Mind Binding
  - Sadness and happiness

- Biological connection to mental states
- Mental connection to biological states
- Cognitive states reflecting body (organs)
   conditions



### **Emotion**

- Fear
- Angry
- Happiness / Joy
- Sadness
- Disappointment

The evolutionary advantages brought by emotion




