$$c = \frac{1}{\sqrt{\mu_0 \epsilon_0}}$$



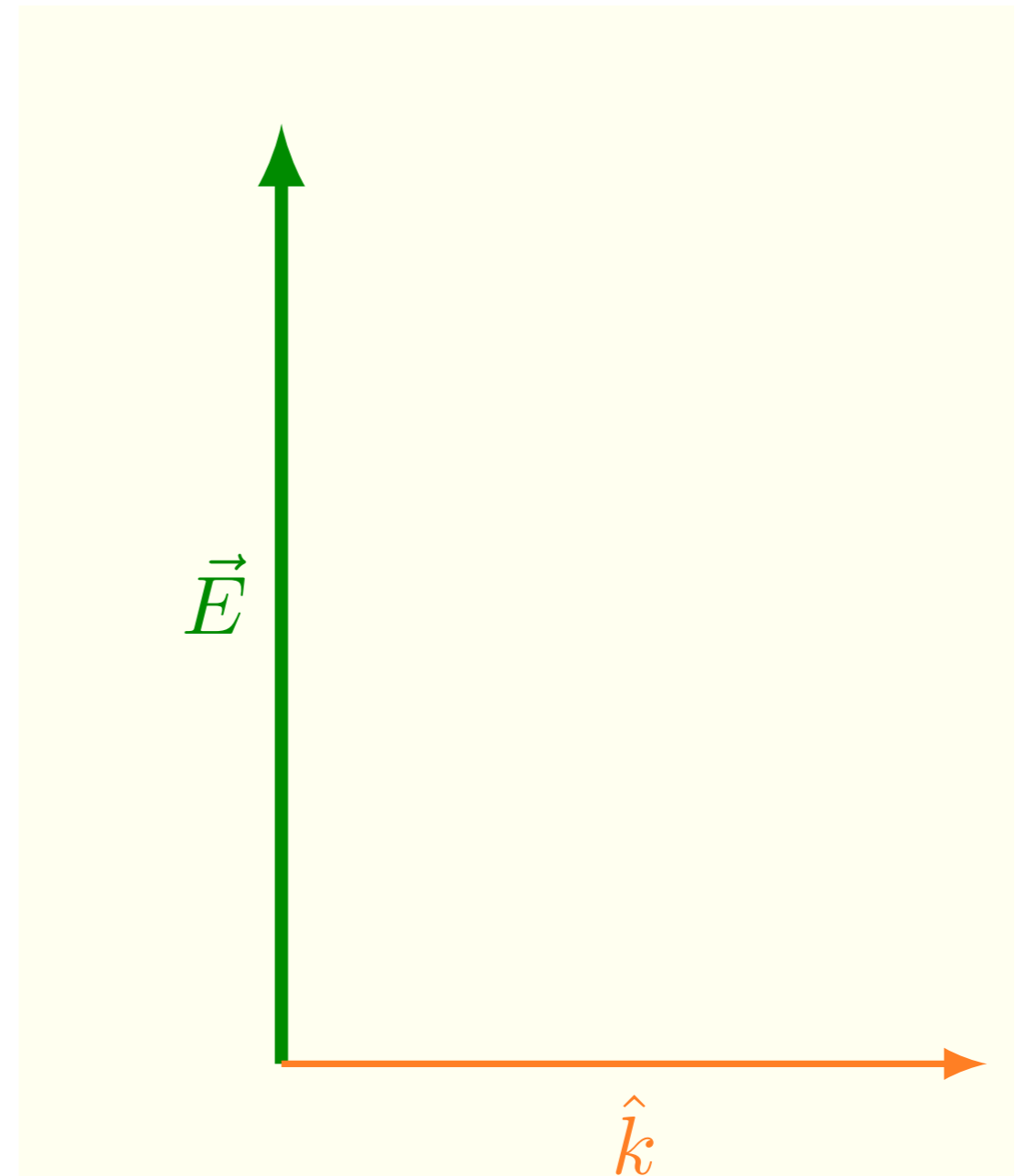
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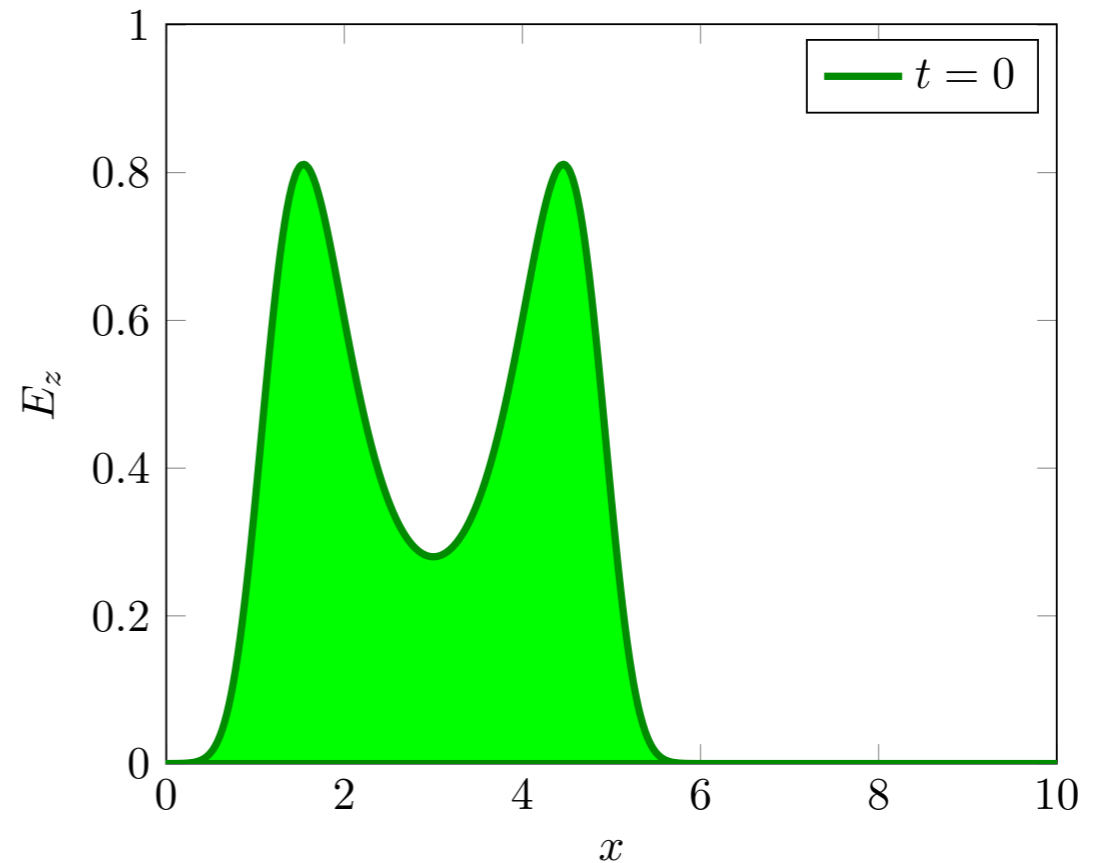
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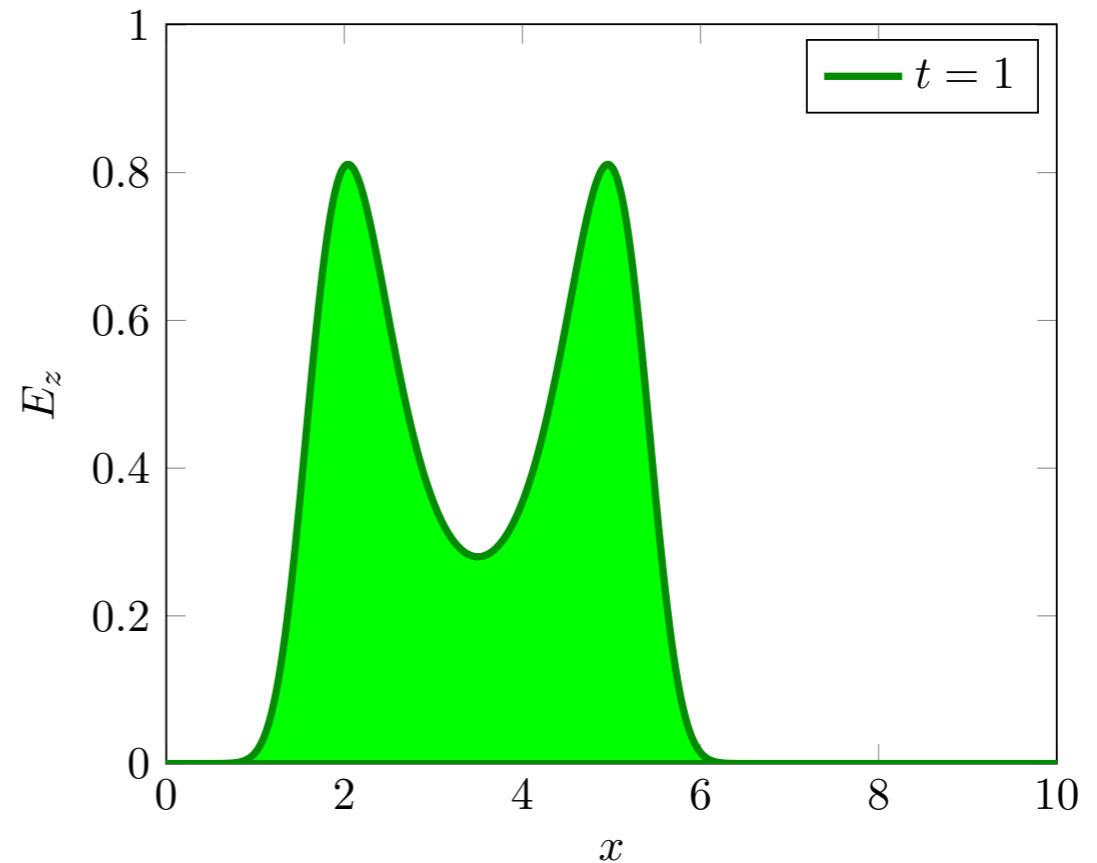
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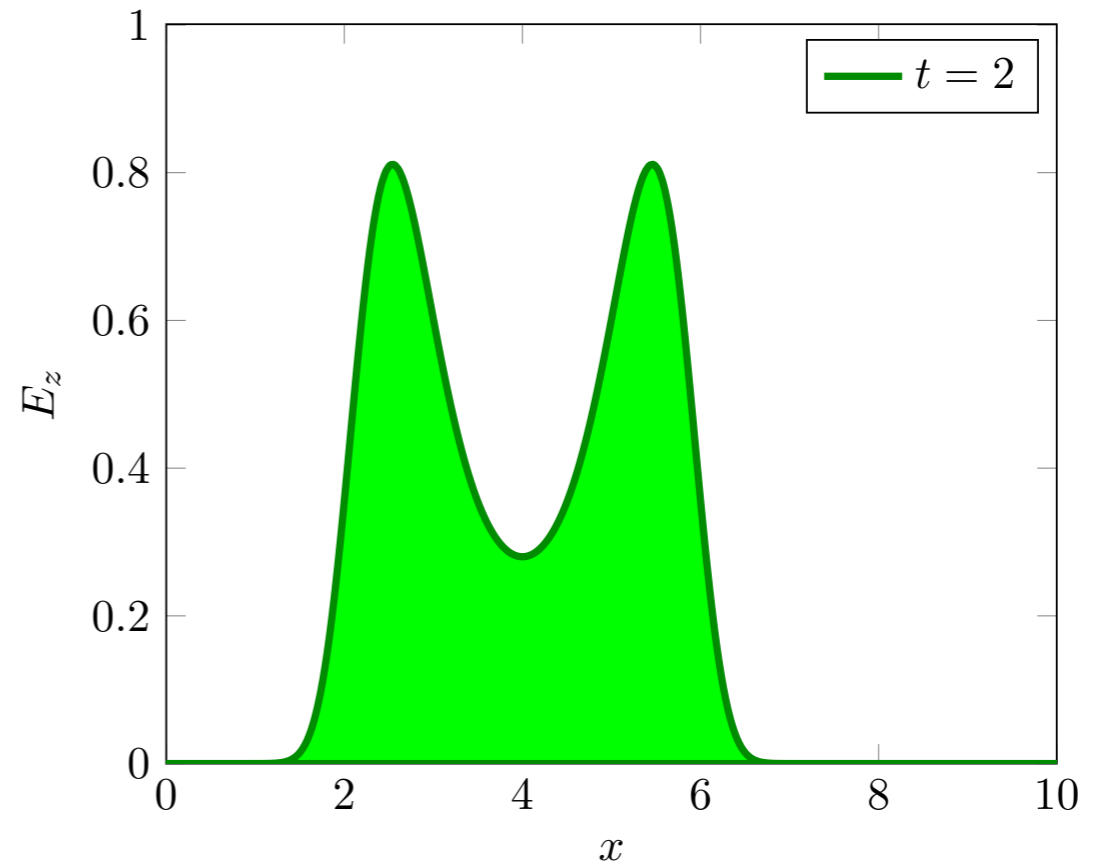
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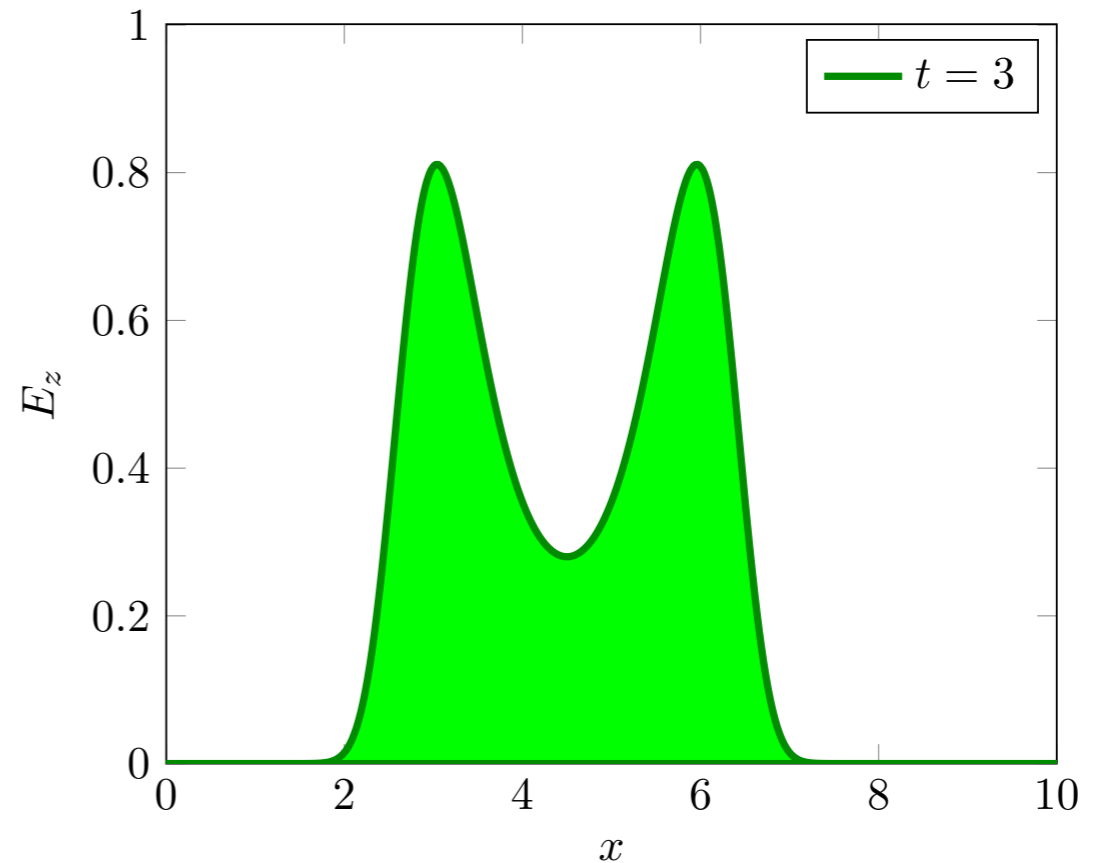
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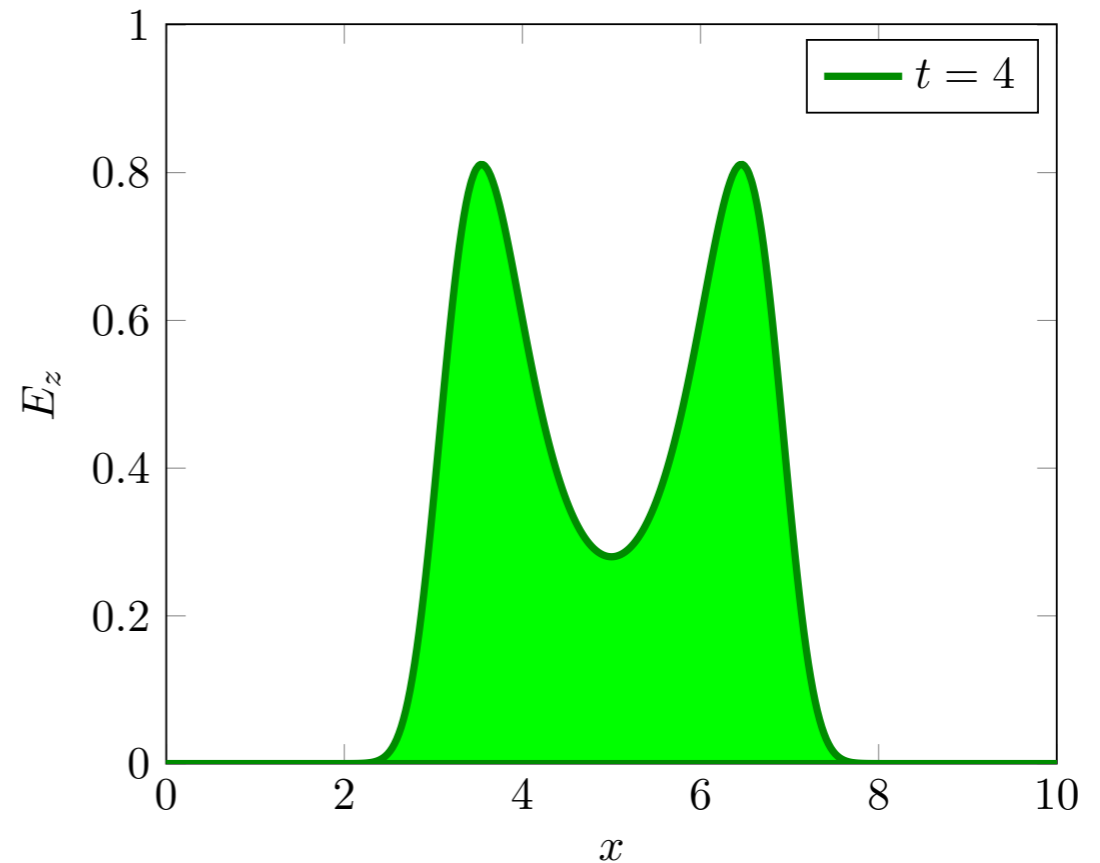
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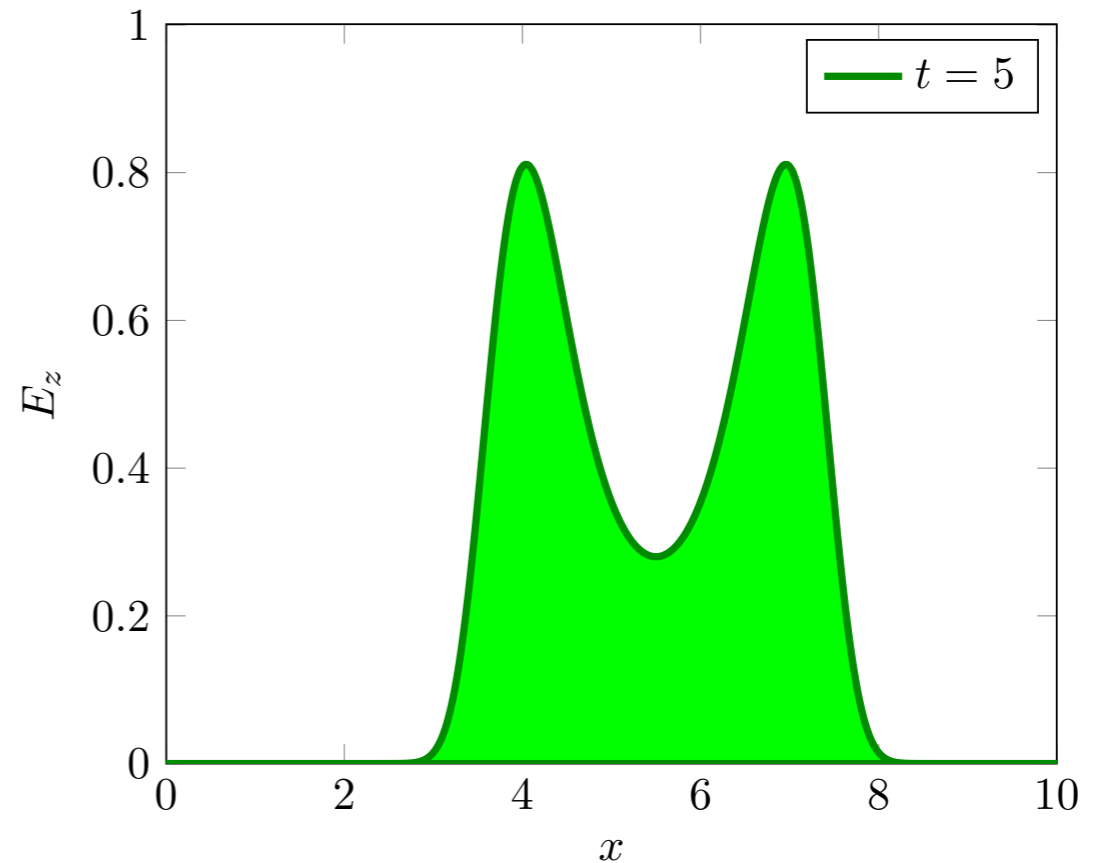

$$\vec{E} = \cos\left(\frac{2\pi x}{3} - \omega t\right) \hat{z}$$

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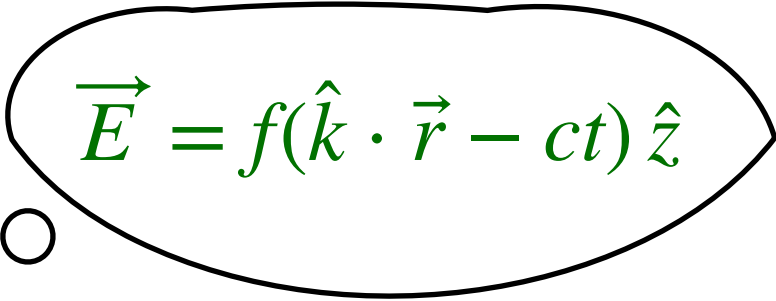



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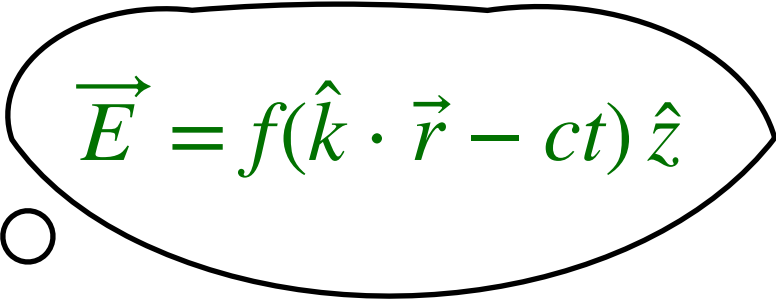

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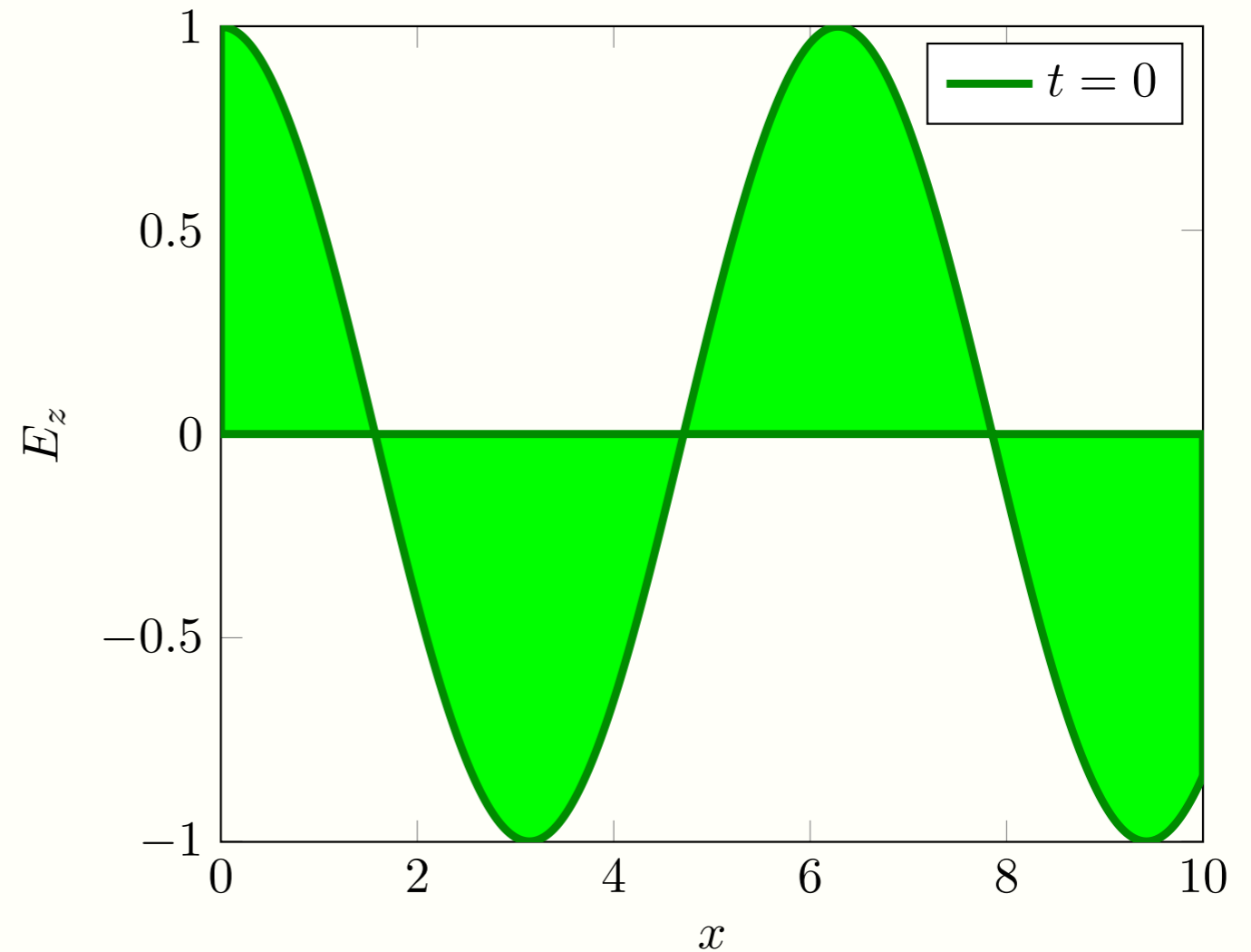


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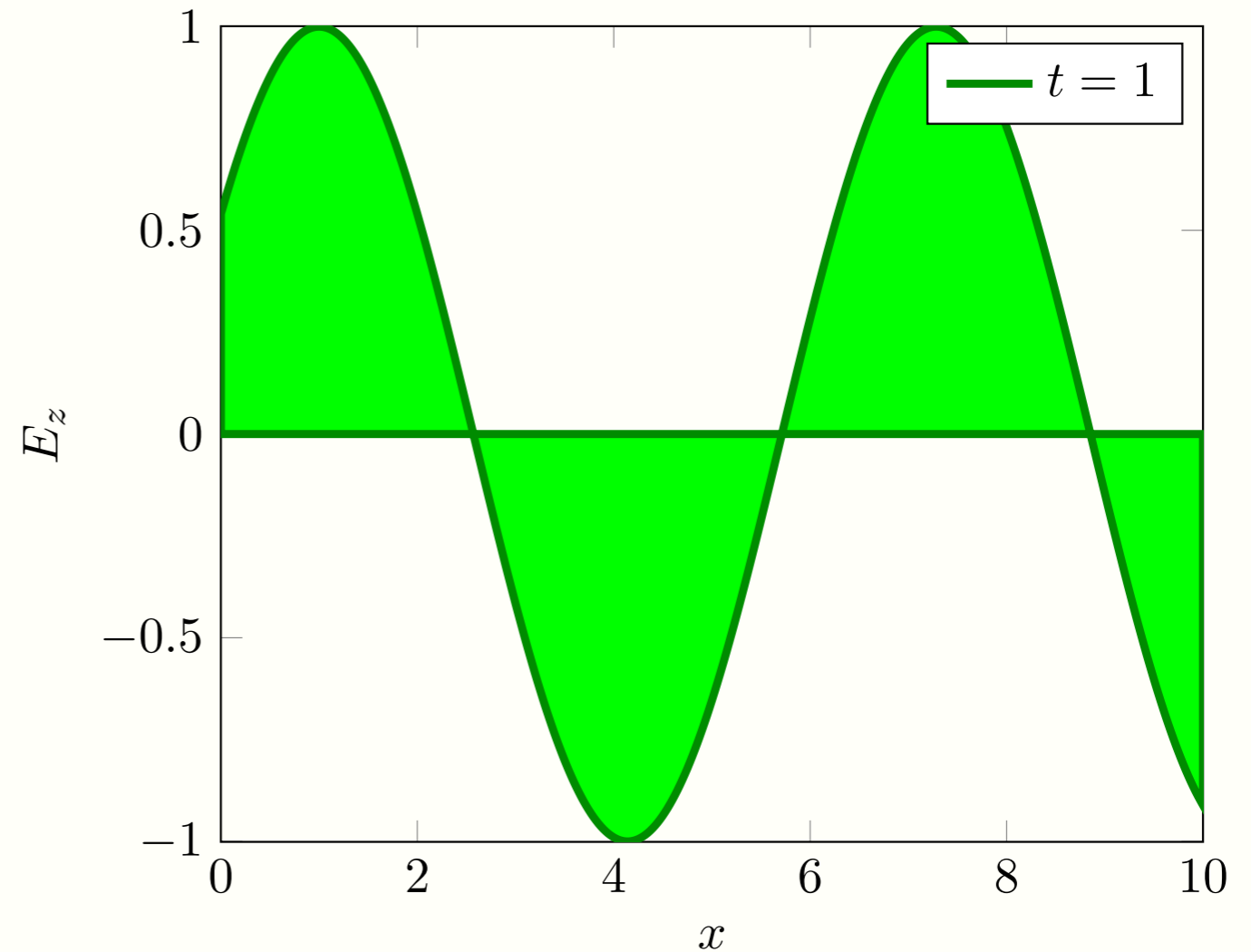


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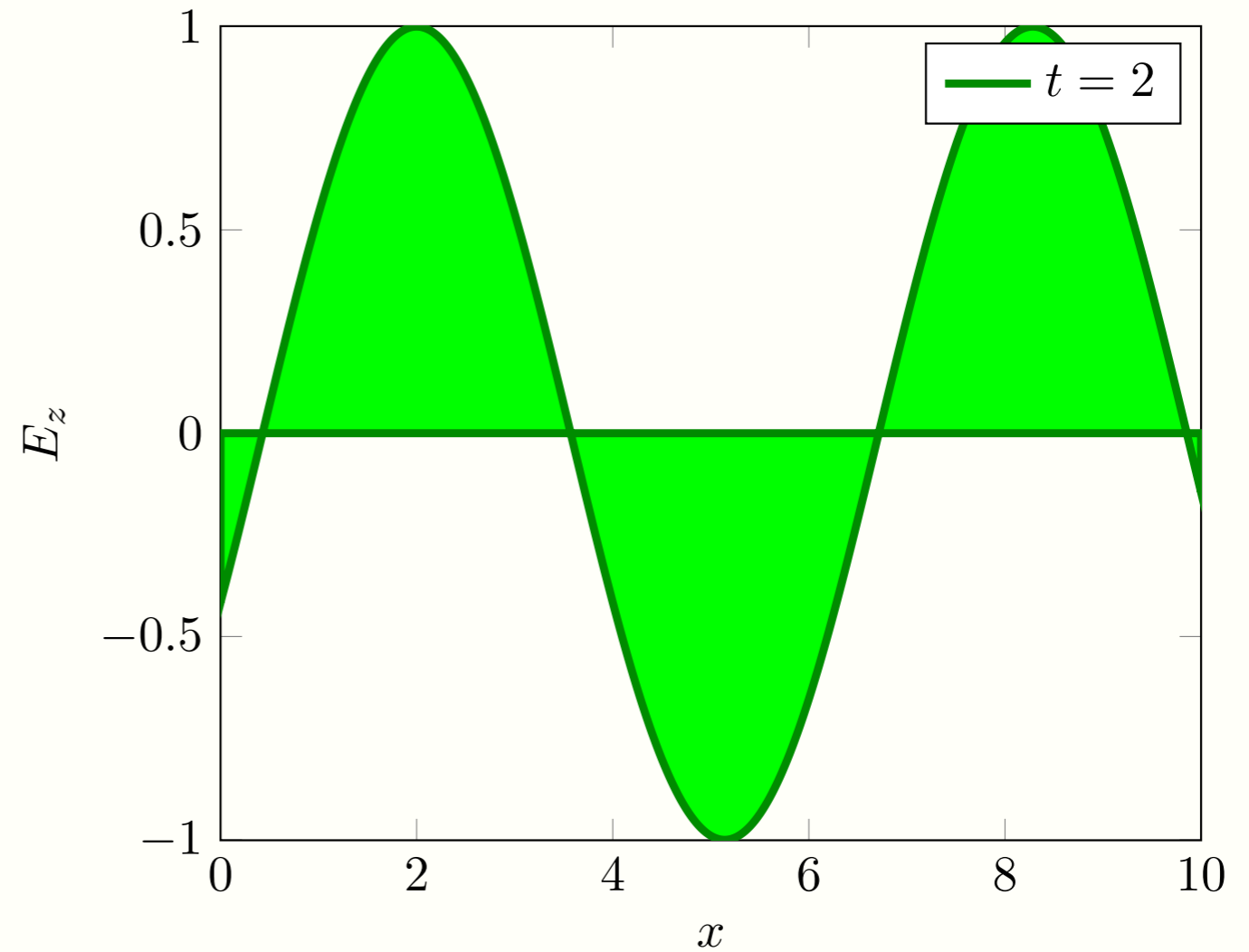


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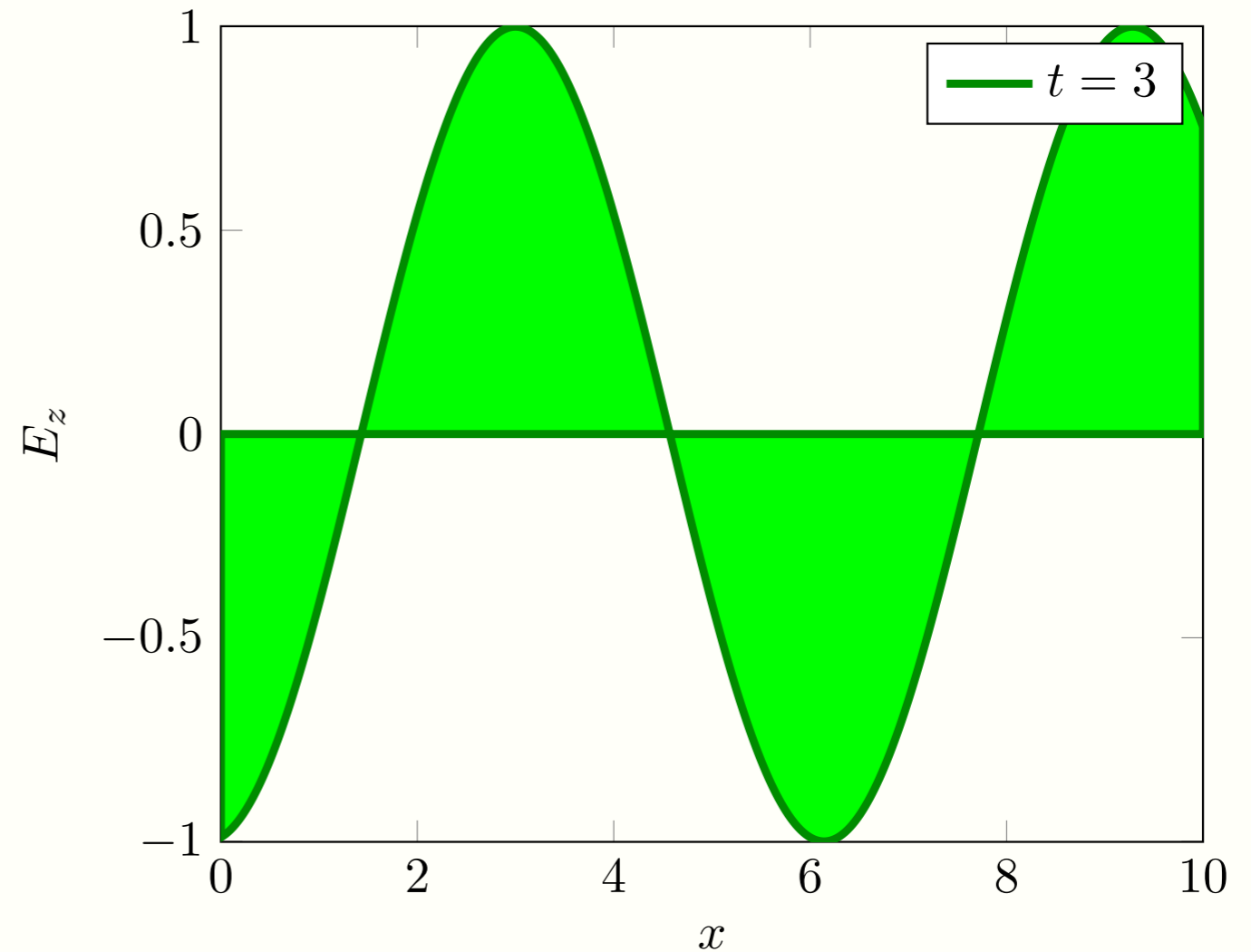


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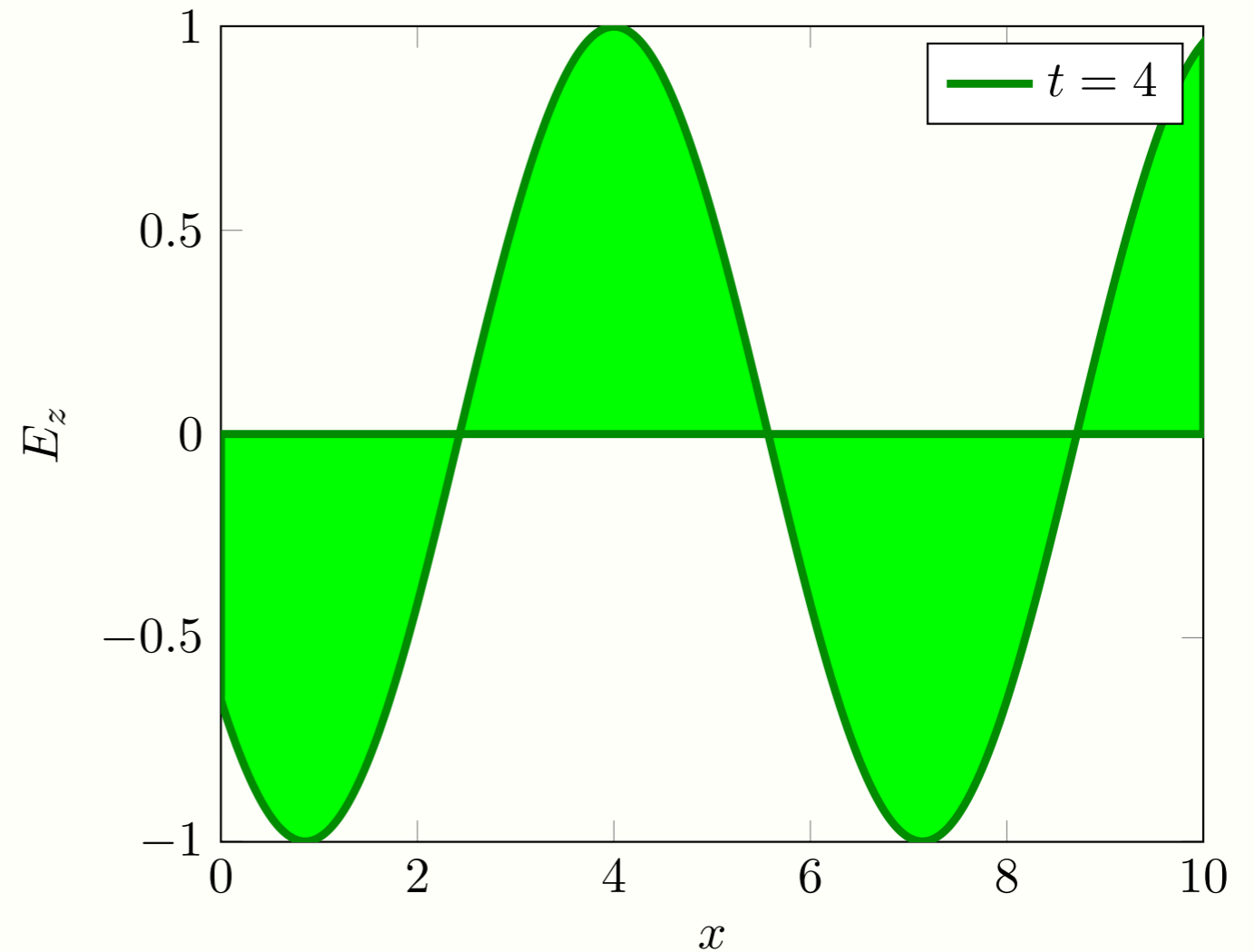


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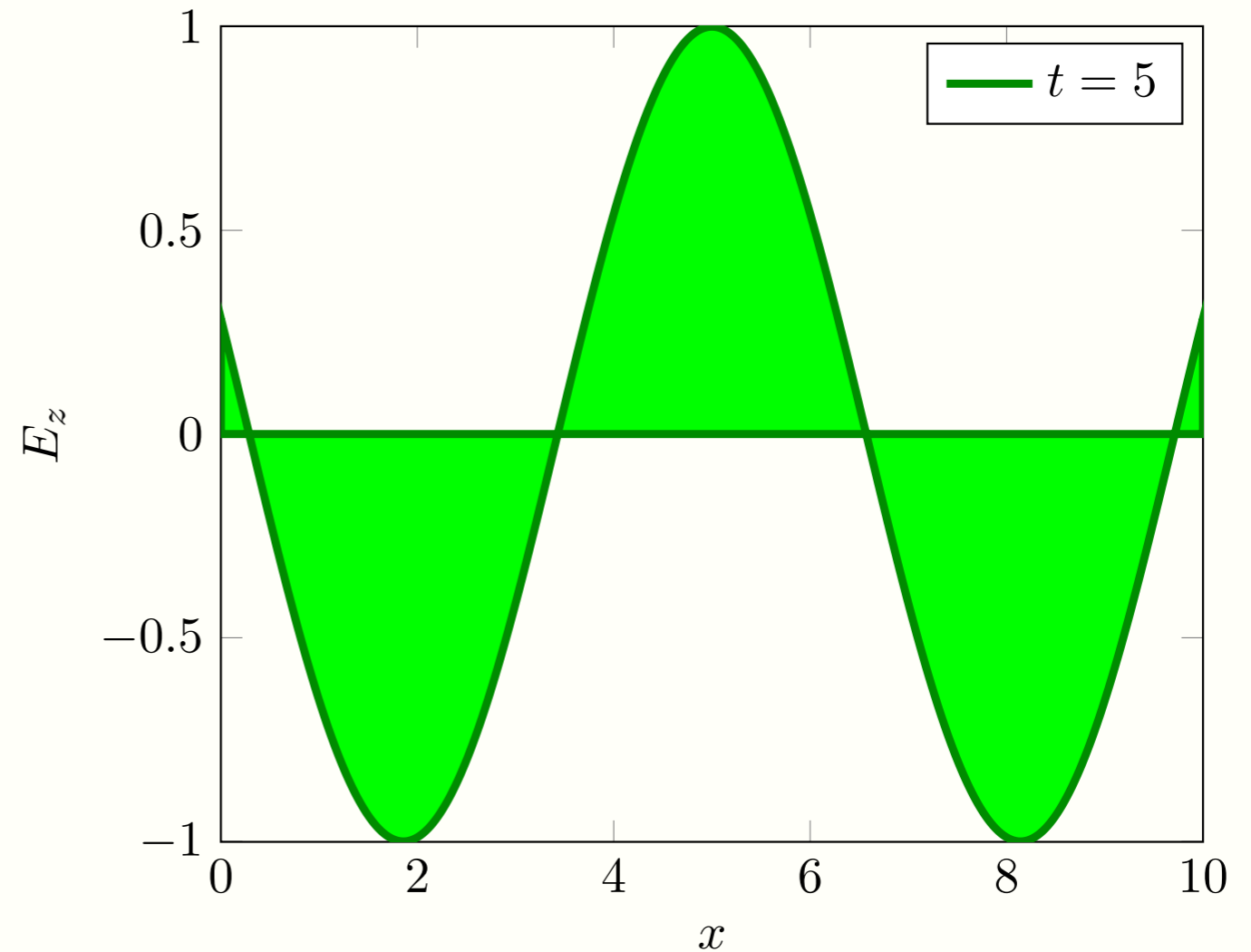
