

BIBLIOGRAPHIC NETWORKS ASSIGNMENT 5

1. Download and install the demo version of HistCite. The program requires Internet Explorer so make sure this is installed on your computer as well. Do not close the small prompt window that opens or HistCite will shut down.
2. Login to ISI Web of Science and perform a search on your topic of interest. Save your results as a Marked List. Export your Marked List as a text file. Make sure that you have checked the box to include the full citations. The number of references will depend upon your topic and the type of search terms you use. You can combine the results of multiple searches in your Marked List before exporting. Too few articles and you will not have a network to visualize
3. In HistCite, click on File and Add File. Locate your ISI text file and bring it into HistCite.
 - a. If you are using Internet Explorer Version 8, you might see an error message, such as File: "C:\fakepath\ISIfilename.txt": No such file or directory", when you try to add a new file. This is due to some changes introduced in Internet Explorer 8.
 - b. The work around is as follows:
 - i. Double click the globe Internet icon at the bottom of your IE8 window
 - ii. Click "Local intranet"
 - iii. Click "Sites"
 - iv. Click "Advanced"
 - v. Make sure http://127.0.0.1 is in the input field
 - vi. Click "Add"
 - vii. Click out of the dialogs with OK.
 - viii. It will now be possible to open files in HistCite as usual
4. Go to Tools and click on Graph Maker. Select by LCS and count. Check the Limit box if it is unchecked and enter the number of references that you are importing. The rest of the settings should be the defaults. Enlarge the font sizes to make the node labels and years more visible.
5. Make a screenshot (ALT-Print Scr) of your list of references in HistCite. These are listed in the lower window in Graph Maker.
6. Save your graph as an image file and import into Powerpoint. Annotate this image so that you can describe the relationships among the papers through time.
