






WHO PAYS FOR HEALTH?




RICHER COUNTRIES SPEND MORE ON HEALTH...




...BUT NOT NECESSARILY AS A SHARE OF GDP



MORE GOVERNMENT SPENDING ON HEALTH IS ASSOCIATED WITH LOWER OUT-OF-POCKET SPENDING






PRIORITY OF HEALTH IN BUDGET ALLOCATION IS A POLITICAL CHOICE




IS RELIANCE ON OUT-OF-POCKET SPENDING DECREASING OVER TIME?
